From the Commander's Desk

As we enter into a new year I would like to share with you a story of compassion, charity and kindness. The weekend of December 17th I was notified by the American Legion Department of Florida about a Veteran in our community who needed assistance. He received a Traumatic Brain Injury while serving our Country in Afghanistan which developed into Narcolepsy. Due to having narcolepsy the military released him from duty in a very short time. He was a US Army Staff Sergeant and is having to fight the Veteran's Administration for his disability. He receives Social Security disability but that is the family's only source of income. His wife is pregnant with a high risk pregnancy requiring bed rest. The family has five children and was fighting to keep the home and keep utilities on in the home. They were having a real difficult time and were having trouble buying food for the family so you can easily see that there was not going to be Christmas for the kids. The American Legion Department of Florida came through and is paying their utilities, but the overwhelming support of Post 75, our community, our City public safety departments and our local veterans made a desperate time in this family's life a little more bearable.

The kindness and generosity shown by our community and our veterans speaks volumes for what we can accomplish when we work together for a common goal. In the very short time from December 17th until Christmas Eve I received donations of cash, checks, gift cards and food exceeding \$2,500.00 which was provided to the family. The Police Department "Cops for Kids" program also provided bicycles and Christmas gifts to the children. Because of you the family's financial burden was reduced and the family had a Christmas that was not going to happen otherwise. I want to thank the many individuals, organizations and businesses that provided donations during these tough economic times. I hope everyone has a happy and prosperous new year.

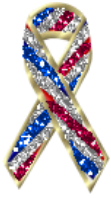

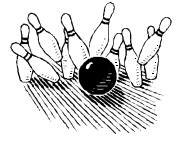
