What is a Stand Down?

Stand Down refers to a grassroots, community-based intervention program designed to help the nation’s estimated 60,000 homeless veterans “combat” life on the streets. Homeless veterans are brought together in a single location for one to three days and are provided access to the community resources needed to begin addressing their individual problems and rebuilding their lives. In the military, Stand Down afforded battle-weary soldiers the opportunity to renew their spirit, health and overall sense of well-being. Today’s Stand Down affords the same opportunity to homeless veterans.

At this stand down we are also offering certain services to our homeless heroes to instill in them some much needed self-confidence, self-esteem and improved appearances; and that’s dental services and Florida IDs. Offering these services is costly so in order to make this a success; we need help from our community to provide certain items and or financial donations. Some of the items most needed are:
