
Subject: Endorsement of Johnny D. Castro for the American Legion, Department of Florida, Southern Area Commander.

During the regularly scheduled meeting on January 7th 2021, the membership of Royal Palm Beach Post 367 unanimously approved Johnny D. Castro for endorsement in the position of Southern Area Commander for the year 2021-2022 with the American Legion, Department of Florida.
