He is ultimately responsible for your behavior while on MacDill AFB. Please follow all posted speed limit signs, and no texting or cell phone use on base. You are guest of this installation.

Base Access and Campsite Guidance



Current and valid DoD or DoD-affiliate ID card holders will have access to MacDill AFB.

A list of participants without a DoD ID card must be received by Chris Ragusa no later than 29 November 2021. Base Security Forces need 3 business days to perform the background check (basically a state and national felony and warrant search).

The Access List for all adults, Scouts and their siblings without a DoD ID will be at both the Main Gate (S. Dale Mabry) and Bayshore Blvd. gates. You will have access to MacDill AFB from Friday - Sunday. If there is an issue, please contact Chris Ragusa (614.940.9291)

Feel free to show up at Lewis Lake any time after 5:00pm on Friday afternoon. The address for mapping purposes is 9249 Marina Bay Dr, Tampa, FL 33621. Our program will run through 12:00pm on Sunday. It will be disruptive if you leave earlier.



- Do not set your tent up near the PortaPotties or handwash stations, in a lower elevation location, or in a common access area.



Meals

Packs are responsible for their own Crackerbarrel on Friday and Saturday nights, and breakfast on Saturday and Sunday.

- Propane and above ground charcoal cooking is permitted
- Leadership agreed to S'Mores as the Saturday night Crackerbarrel...each pack is responsible for their own ingredients and marshmallow burning sticks
- Reusable utensils and plates are encouraged...single use utensils and plates are discouraged.

Saturday's Lunch and Dinner are included in your participation fee, and we'll be eating those meals together

- Lunch will be a cookout at the Base Marina Beach, and will consist of hot dogs, hamburgers, potato chips and Goldfish crackers, fruit, water, and lemonade. Service will begin at 12:00pm. Bring your camp chairs.
- We need a minimum of 2 adult volunteers from each pack to help prepare and serve our Lunch meal!
- Dinner is a catered barbecue meal from Bubbaques, and will be served at the Lewis Lake pavilion. We will enjoy pulled pork, chicken, ribs, mac/cheese, grilled corn, green beans, broccoli, baked beans, and banana pudding. Service will begin at 5:30pm.
- We need a minimum of 2 adult volunteers from each pack to help serve our meal.



Notes (1)

Parents are responsible for their Scout's behavior at camp and during the Program events.

Opening flags on both Saturday and Sunday morning at the Parade Field at 8:00am sharp...
SCOUTS AND LEADERS IN FIELD UNIFORM! Activity Uniform for the balance of the time.

Unless you have special dispensation, firearms are not permitted on MacDill AFB.

We will be using the BB guns, archery bows/arrows, and targets from one of the Greater Tampa Bay Area Council camps...DO NOT BRING YOUR OWN WEAPONS! All weapons must be secured in the Base Armory overnight.

There are no electrical drops at Lewis Lake (even in the pavilion)....BRING HEAD LAMPS AND FLASHLIGHTS!

There are not enough picnic tables and chairs to accommodate everyone – YOU MUST BRING A CAMP CHAIR FOR YOUR FAMILY!

Lewis Lake campsite is a primitive camping area – bring drinking water bottles (one of the six Cub Scout Essentials). We have additional Porta-Potties and handwash stations for your use. There are no showers. Nevertheless, A SCOUT IS CLEAN.



Notes (2)

Absolutely no Scouts in either fire pit area...FIRE PITS ARE NOT PLAYGROUNDS.

Fishing is permitted in Lewis Lake. You must provide your own gear.

The Scout Sunday Interfaith Worship Service will be led by Scott Burkett (Cubmaster for Pack 1381). You are strongly encouraged to attend. Scott knows what he is doing.

You do not/need a DoD ID card to eat at the Base Exchange Food Court or Burger King restaurants while on base. You DO need a DoD ID to shop at the Base Commissary and Base Exchange.
