To be considered for Florida American Legion Boys State you must **schedule an interview with an American Legion Post close to you**. Your school Guidance Counselor may be in touch with the local Post and know who to contact for an interview. If not, contact the state Programs Director by calling 800.393.3378x235 or email programs@floridalegion.org.

Selected applicants will be awarded an all-expense paid trip to Tallahassee. They will participate in events on the campus of Florida State University.

To be eligible, you **must have completed 11th grade by the end of the 2027 school year and have at least one full semester remaining in your senior year**. Florida American Legion Boys State is the premier youth leadership program in Florida. This application will be used by your local American Legion Post for your interview.
